

2020 Acworth Business Association Scholarship

The Acworth Business Association has six scholarships available to high school students who fit the eligibility criteria. This document contains information about all of the scholarships, as well as the forms necessary to apply for each scholarship.

About Acworth Business Association

The Acworth Business Association seeks to leverage strategic partnerships, facilitate better business practices, and enhance the value of the goods and services of the businesses within the community that enrich the quality of life of our residents and community.

Recipient's Obligation

Acceptance of the award constitutes permission for Acworth Business Association to use the recipient's name in recognition as a recipient of the scholarship in the organization's publications and announcements. Furthermore, recipient agrees to provide official documentation indicating full-time enrollment at the college or university of her choice before payment will be made. Failure to supply documentation as a registered, degree seeking student will result in revocation of the full amount of the award.

Award Notification and Payment

The winning scholarship recipient will be notified via email no later than April 15, 2020. Scholarships will be awarded on May 7, 2020 at the ABA Luncheon. Scholarship payment will be made in one installment in August 2020 upon receipt of official notification of enrollment/registration for classes. Payment will be made directly to the college or university on behalf of the recipient.

Scholarship Instructions & Guidelines

The Acworth Business Association annually awards Scholarships to (6) graduating high school seniors whom have demonstrated academic excellence, outstanding leadership, service within their community, entrepreneurial spirit, and extra-curricular success within athletics or fine arts while participating in their schools. Scholarship honoree will receive a \$1,000 scholarship to offset the cost of educational expenses including, but not limited to, tuition, room & board, or books.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible for consideration by the Acworth Business Association Scholarship Selection Committee:

- 1. Graduating senior from the following member high school(s): Allatoona, Harrison, Kennesaw Mountain, North Cobb, North Paulding or Private (Brookwood Christian, Cornerstone, North Cobb Christian).
- 2. Minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 3. Demonstrate active participation in extracurricular activities.
- 4. Demonstrate active involvement within their community through community service.
- 5. Leadership, Employment, Awards & Recognition while not required are highly valued

Application Criteria

Applicant complete, include, and submit all of the following for consideration by the Scholarship Selection Committee. Any incomplete applications will not receive consideration:

- 1. List of all school, community, and/or extracurricular activities, including leadership positions
- 2. A copy of high school transcript.
- **3.** Provide proof of intent to enroll full-time in a fully accredited technical college, trade school or two/four-year college/university undergraduate program beginning no later than Fall 2019 by submitting one of the following:
 - A copy of an acceptance letter for chosen college/university if available prior to application deadline
 - A copy of submitted application for chosen college/university and status if available should no acceptance letter be available prior to application deadline
- 4. Applicant must submit one (1) letter of support/ recommendation from an individual, such as a teacher, coach, principal, employer, or pastor, who are qualified to address the candidate's qualities, community impact and suitability for this award.
- 5. Submit a personally written essay (300 words or less) outlining the applicant's future goals, aspirations, and what it means to "Create your own success."

The Acworth Business Association Scholarship honorees receive a \$1,000 scholarship award to help offset the cost of educational expenses including, but not limited to, tuition, housing, board, or books. Scholarships will be awarded on May 7, 2020 at the ABA Luncheon.

- Discuss the applicant's potential for future success.
- Please provide any additional comments or insights relating to the applicant; such as motivation, initiative in pursuing goals, work responsibilities, community service, etc.; that you feel would be helpful for the committee to know.

Your letter of support should be placed in a sealed and signed envelope. The letter should then be returned to the applicant for inclusion in the scholarship application.
