# Scholarship Program General Information 2022

#### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The 2022 program provides five \$2000 scholarships to students who reside in Georgia. Scholarships are awarded based on applicant achievement in:

- community service,
- school and leadership activities,
- and academic excellence.

The scholarship is a one-time award and is payable to an accredited post-secondary institution, skill/training center or trade school, not the student. The funds are provided to assist students with tuition, required registration or other fees.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

The AT&T Georgia Pioneers' mission is a commitment to making a positive difference in our communities. Each applicant must have demonstrated a similar commitment by volunteering a minimum of 50 hours in the community in the last year (April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022).

In addition, all applicants (high school seniors and/or post-secondary students) must meet the following requirements:

- They must reside in Georgia, but may be attending an institution or school outside of the state of Georgia.
- They must be planning to enter or currently be attending an accredited post-secondary college or trade school. The institution must be willing
  to accept the scholarship payment from the Pioneers and credit it to the student's account. The check will be made payable to the school and
  mailed to the school. This regulation cannot be waived.
- The applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 2.50.
- Students cannot win in 2 consecutive years. Students who were awarded the AT&T Georgia Pioneers Scholarship in 2021 are not eligible to win in 2022.
- Eligibility includes, but is not limited to, relatives and friends of Pioneers

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

Eligible students must submit the following:

- The completed scholarship application.
  - o the hard-copy application must be submitted with original signatures of the student applicant.
- The requested documentation as shown in the instructions.
- A certified copy of the most current cumulative grade transcript. In most cases the transcript should cover the semester completing the 2021 2022 school year.
- The complete application should be mailed by First Class or Priority Mail;
  - Delivery Confirmation is suggested, but not required. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, applications
    not including all requested information by the due date are ineligible for consideration.
  - The application and all supporting documentation must be postmarked by June 01, 2022 and sent to:

All information received is considered confidential and will be properly safeguarded.

#### **JUDGES**

Recipients are selected by a panel of external judges who are not employees of the AT&T Georgia Pioneers Corporation. An AT&T Georgia Pioneers team will oversee the process, but will not participate in judging.

#### APPLICATION RECEIPT NOTIFICATION

The AT&T Georgia Pioneers will send a letter of notification (email or US Mail) to each scholarship applicant upon receipt of the application (postmark deadline for submittal is **June 01**, **2022**). Questions may be directed to the Administrator at email **GaPioneersScholarship@gmail.com**.

#### WINNER NOTIFICATION AND AWARD PROCESS

Both winners and non-winners will be notified as explained above by July 18, 2022.

The scholarship payment process follows:

- After notification the winners must supply an invoice from their school showing their financial responsibility. Send to the administrator's postal or email address by August 15, 2022.
- The checks will be made payable to and mailed to the various institutions by August 31, 2022.
- The AT&T Georgia Pioneers may recognize the scholarship winners at local Pioneer meetings and events and in Pioneer or sponsor company publications.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS**

The recipients will be selected on the basis of performance in three key areas. Each applicant may receive points from zero up to the total allotted in each category: Each of the applicants will be assigned a point value in each category by individual judges: total points will be summarized for a final score. The five applicants with the highest total scores will be awarded the scholarships. Individual feedback about the judges' evaluation will not be provided. The decision of the AT&T Georgia Pioneers is final.

#### 1. Community Service (50 points)

- The applicant is asked to provide a list of volunteer activities in the past 12 months (April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022).
  - o There should be a minimum of 50 hours shown on the applicant's list of volunteer activities.
- In addition, the applicant should provide a one-page letter from a **non-family member** describing the applicant's volunteer involvement and accomplishments in one of the projects listed.

#### 2. Written Essay – (25 points)

- Essay describing in 1,000 words or less what has been the most rewarding community service activity the applicant has participated in and why it was important to the applicant. The essay should include 5 basic points:
  - o The applicant's role in the project.
  - Time spent on the project hours, days, etc.
  - o One-time or an ongoing effort
  - o Impact of project on applicant.
  - Why applicant feels his/her involvement in the project qualifies him/her to apply for this scholarship.

#### 3. Academic and Leadership Activities in School – (25 points)

- Academic Excellence
  - The applicant is required to provide cumulative GPA or cumulative numerical grade along with a certified copy of the most current school grade transcript.
- Leadership Activities in School
  - o Also required is a list of School Leadership Activities in high school/college.
  - o In addition, the applicant should provide a single one-page letter from a **non-family member** describing the applicant's involvement and accomplishments in one of the activities listed.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Q. Who can apply for this scholarship?

**A.** High school seniors and/or college students residing in Georgia are eligible to apply. See section on "Eligibility" on page 1. Note: the applicants must be residents of Georgia, but may be attending a post-secondary school outside the state of Georgia.

#### Q. How are scholarships awarded?

A. A maximum of five \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded. Each recipient may receive one of the five based on established criteria as defined in this document.

#### Q. Are scholarship awards based on financial need?

A. No. Scholarship awards are based on the three key areas defined in the selection process.

#### Q. How might I appeal scholarship allocations?

**A.** The scholarship awards are based on criteria established by the AT&T Georgia Pioneers and the decisions are final. Information submitted by the applicant and any information utilized in selecting recipients is confidential and is the property of the AT&T Georgia Pioneers Corporation and is not subject to disclosure. This information will be properly safeguarded.

#### Q. How are judges selected?

**A.** Judges may be selected through a variety of means as deemed appropriate by the Pioneers Scholarship Program Administrator Board. Judges will be non-Pioneers who may be a representative of a Pioneers partnership organization or other community-based organizations.

#### Q. Can multiple family members submit an application during the same period?

A. Yes.

#### Q. Can parts of the application be submitted at different times as long as all information is in by the deadline?

A. No. Information received with the application will be considered the entire submission and will be evaluated solely on that information.

#### Q. Can part of the information be submitted by FAX and part submitted through the mail?

**A.** No, all information to be considered MUST BE MAILED together with the application as one package postmarked by June 01, 2022. Faxes and electronic submissions will not be accepted. Priority Mail delivery confirmation is recommended.

### Q. Will scholarships be payable to the applicant if career plans change and the applicant does not enter an accredited institution as defined in the program?

**A.** No. Scholarships will not be payable to individuals. This regulation cannot be waived. The scholarships are designed to assist scholarship recipients with expenses associated with school tuition, required registration and other fees and will be directed to the institution indicated by the scholarship winner. It is the winner's responsibility to notify the administrator of any changes in the selected institution.

- Send the application First Class or Priority mail postmarked no later than **June 01**, **2022**. Delivery confirmation is suggested, but not required. Applicants are responsible for verifying that the application has been received by using the USPS web site.

- Send only pages of the application shown below. Do not send instructions or other pages of the scholarship package.
- Do not staple any pages. Paper clips may be used if desired.
