#### **BACKGROUND**

This scholarship honors the memory and legacy of Anna V. Waters (1918 - 2006), who lived, worked, and raised her family in Baltimore, Maryland. Ms. Waters' life was distinguished by her superior character and heartfelt service to others. She grew up on the Eastern Shore of Maryland and her mantra was "do for self," stressing hard work and perseverance in the face of life's obstacles. Above all, however, she was committed to ensuring a good education for all young people. A nurse by profession, she consistently demonstrated a strong work ethic. She instilled this work ethic in her children and grandchildren, who all attended Baltimore area schools, which led them to productive professional lives. In memory of her belief in "do for self" and her commitment to the education of young people, we offer this scholarship to support high school graduates in achieving their educational goals.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- African American students planning to attend college, technical, or vocational school
- Cumulative Unweighted Grade Point Average: 2.0 − 2.9
- Good character and commitment to community
- Potential to do well in college, technical, or vocational school

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply students must complete the application, type answers to the five questions, and submit all required items:

- completed application
- two letters of recommendation
- an updated, official transcript
- a resume
- at least one acceptance letter from a college, technical or vocational school
- one recent photo (to be used in awards ceremony program)

To be competitive, students should submit *complete* applications that have been carefully *edited*. Incomplete applications and those postmarked after the deadline of April 1st will not be considered.

#### **AWARDS**

Scholarships will be awarded in varying amounts, ranging from \$500 - \$2,000. Award recipients will be recognized at an event in Baltimore, MD on June 22nd, 2019. Awards may be used for books, fees or tuition. Winners may reapply for additional awards after satisfactory completion of two semesters at a postsecondary institution. Winners will need verification of enrollment no later than September 15<sup>th</sup>. All scholarships will be sent directly to the institution and dispersed in two equal parts during the fall and spring semesters.
