Frederick N. Pinkston Achievement Scholarship

Applications for scholarship are now being accepted for the 2018-19 school year.

The Carrollton-Douglasville Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc maintains scholarship funding through fundraising and voluntary contributions. We are seeking to award the Frederick N. Pinkston Achievement Scholarship to one well deserving male student, from the Carroll, Douglas, or Paulding County School Systems. The scholarship award amount will be \$1,000. Funds are to be used for tuition, fees or books and will be paid directly to the college or university where the student is enrolled.

- ✓ Three (3) Letters of Recommendation
- ✓ Official High School Transcript and Test Scores
- ✓ College Acceptance Letter

Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Academics (GPA and Test Scores)
- Essay
- Extra-Curricular Activities / Community Service
- Recommendation Letters

Deadline: Completed applications must be received no later than April 5, 2018

****Winner will be notified by April 9, 2018 and Scholarship will be officially announced at a formal ceremony on April 22, 2018.***
