



2024 North Georgia State Fair Scholarship

The North Georgia State Fair and Drew Exposition will award six \$5,000 scholarships to high school students who fit the eligibility criteria. This document contains information about all of the scholarships, as well as the forms necessary to apply for each scholarship.

About North Georgia State Fair

The purpose of the North Georgia State Fair is to sponsor a county fair for the welfare of agricultural, recreational, educational, business, and industrial interests of the North Georgia area. To promote youth programs, youth clubs, and youth organizations as approved by the Board of Directors. To furnish a medium of cooperation between the people in North Georgia and the business community of North Georgia and to promote the industrial development of the North Georgia area. To encourage and promote additional educational opportunities for all citizens of the North Georgia area.

Recipient's Obligation

Acceptance of the award constitutes permission for The North Georgia State Fair to use the recipient's name and likeness in recognition as a recipient of the scholarship in the organization's publications, website, social media and announcements. Furthermore, recipient agrees to provide official documentation indicating full-time enrollment at the college, university, or trade school of their choice before payment will be made. Failure to supply documentation as a registered, degree seeking student will result in revocation of the full amount of the award.

Award Notification and Payment

The winning scholarship recipient will be notified via email no later than April 26th. Scholarships will be awarded at The North Georgia State Fair Board of Directors meeting in June. Scholarship payment will be made in one installment in August upon receipt of official notification of enrollment/registration for classes. Payment will be made directly to the college, university or trade school on behalf of the recipient.

Qualified individuals wishing to be considered for the North Georgia State Fair 2024 Scholarship must submit an application meeting all previous outlined requirement to the North Georgia State Fair by March 29th.

Scholarship Instructions and Guidelines

The North Georgia State Fair and Drew Exposition annually awards six (6) scholarships to graduating high school seniors who have demonstrated academic excellence, outstanding leadership, service within their community, entrepreneurial spirit, and extra-curricular success within athletics or fine arts while participating in their schools. Scholarship honoree will receive a \$5,000 scholarship to offset the cost of educational expenses including, but not limited to, tuition, room & board, or books.

Eligible Criteria

Applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible for consideration by the North Georgia State Fair Scholarship Selection Committee:

- 1. Graduating senior from a high school in Cobb County to include public, private and/or home schooled.
- 2. Minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 3. Demonstrate active participation in extracurricular activities.
- 4. Demonstrate active involvement within their community through community service.
- 5. Leadership, Employment, Awards & Recognition while not required are highly valued.

Application criteria

Completed application must be submitted by March 29th to be considered by the Scholarship Selection Committee. Any incomplete applications will not be considered. Criteria includes:

- 1. List of all school, community, and/or extracurricular activities, including leadership positions.
- 2. A copy of high school transcript.
- 3. Provide proof of intent to enroll full-time in a fully accredited technical college, trade school or two/four-year college/university undergraduate program beginning no later than Fall 2024 by submitting one of the following:
 - a. A copy of an acceptance letter for chosen college, university or trade school if available prior to application deadline.
 - b. A copy of submitted application for chosen college, university or trade school and status if available should no acceptance letter be available prior to application deadline.
- 4. Applicant must submit one (1) letter of support/recommendation from an individual, such as a teacher, coach, principal, employer, or pastor, who are qualified to address the candidate's qualities, community impact and suitability for this award.
- 5. Submit a personally written essay (300 words or less) outlining the applicant's future goals and aspirations.

The North Georgia State Fair Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated success in the classroom, evidence of extracurricular activities, shown leadership qualities, and given back to their community. Awards are made to high school seniors at Cobb County Schools, City of Marietta Schools or qualifying private/home schools. The individual must plan to attend a fully accredited two or four-year college, university, or trade school, starting no later than Fall 2024.

The North Georgia State Fair Scholarship honorees receive a \$5,000 scholarship award to help offset the cost of educational expenses including but not limited to, tuition, housing, board, or books. Scholarship recipient will receive notification by April 26th that they will be awarded the scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded at the June North Georgia State Fair Board Meeting.

The North Georgia State Fair Scholarship Selection Committee values your observations, feedback, and evaluation of the applicant's suitability for this award. The following items should be addressed in the letter of support:

- How long and under what circumstances have you come to know the applicant?
- Describe the applicant's strengths and personal characteristics. We are particularly interested in the applicants' academic excellence, outstanding leadership, service within their community, entrepreneurial spirit, and extra-curricular success within athletics or fine arts.
- Discuss the applicant's potential for future success.
- Please provide any additional comments or insights relating to the applicant. This can include motivation, initiative in pursing goals, work responsibilities, community service, etc.

Your letter of support should be placed in a sealed and signed envelope. The letter should then be returned to the applicant for inclusion in the scholarship application.


