

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Over the next several weeks, the counseling team will work with students by grade level to complete several tasks.

- A. Students will complete their Bridge Bill activity, a task required by the Georgia Department of Education for all students and is grade-level specific. These activities, found in Infinite Campus, are to aid in preparing your student for life after high school.
- B. Students will begin registering for their 24-25 school year and will choose their electives.

Students will choose **Eight (8)** electives. Students may be scheduled for any of their 8 elective choices and should choose their electives carefully. Elective changes may not be made after the school year begins. Please encourage your student to review all elective options and read course descriptions before submitting their elective form. Students will use the form below to make their elective selections. **Students should only submit one form.** If your student needs to change their original elective form entry, the student must email their assigned counselor with the updated request. Students who enter more than one elective form may confuse scheduling for next year. **Electives submissions are due Sunday, February 4th:**

- D. **Teachers will make the academic/core course recommendations for students.**
- E. Once all electives and core academic courses have been entered into your student's academic planner, you will receive an email to review and sign off on these courses for the 24-25 school year using the academic planner located in Infinite Campus.
- F. Students who have not completed the State Health Survey and Drug-Free Paulding Survey, will do so during their meeting with the counselor. This anonymous yearly survey allows our school and district office to purchase and implement
