courage, patriotism, citizenship, honesty, fairness, respect for others, kindness, cooperation, self-respect, self-control, courtesy, compassion, tolerance, diligence, generosity, punctuality, cleanliness, cheerfulness, school pride, respect for the environment, respect for the creator, patience, creativity, sportsmanship loyalty, perseverance, and virtue.

In 800 words or fewer, please write an essay about a person in American History who exemplified one or more of these character traits.

Deadline: December 1, 2016

Who Qualifies: Any High School student in the 12th grade or equivalent if student is enrolled in a non-traditional learning experience. In order to qualify, you must be domiciled within the state of Georgia.
